# "ANVERSA" **JERSEY**

# CAREZZA yarn



#### MATERIALS ADRIAFIL YARNS

**MATERIALS REQUIRED** 

A total of 200 g. **Carezza** yarn subdivided into 50 g. for each of the following colours plum no. 88, salmon pink no. 80, brown no. 87 and yelfow no. 81. Knitting needles no. 51/2. Circular knitting needles no. 51/2. Tapestry needle.

**SIZE:** 44 (40-46)

## PATTERN STITCHES

Elastic rib (start and end) Rib stitch 1/1

Knit stitch

Openwork stripes (work over even stitches):

Row 1: knit.
Row 2: purl.
Rows 3 and 4: knit.
Row 5: kl, \* 1 yo, k2 tog. \*, rep. from \* to \*, k1 .
Rows 6 and 7: knit.

Row 8: purl. Row 9: rep. from row 1

Short stitch over elastic rib

10x10 cm. with knitting needles no. 51/2 in rows of openwork = 18 sts. and 25 rows.

### WORKING INSTRUCTIONS

**WORKING INSTRUCTIONS Back:** with knitting needles 51/2 and the plum yarn cast on 90 (86-94) sts. and, to shape edge, work 4 rows in elastic rib and 4 rows in rib stitch 1/1, corresponding to 3 cm. Cont. in rows of openwork alternating 8 rows with salmon pink, 8 rows with the brown and 8 rows with the yellow yarn. When work measures 29 (28-30) cm. from edge, to shape armholes bind off on sides, every 2 rows, 4 sts., 2 sts. twice, 1 st. twice. When work measures 13 cm. from beg. of armholes, to shape the shoulder slant bind off on sides 4 sts. every 2 rows 4 times (4 sts. 3 times, 3 sts. - 5 sts., 4 sts. 3 times). When work measures 3 cm. from beg. of slant bind off the rem. 38 (36-40) sts.

**Front:** work in same way as back until work measures 29 (28-30) cm. Shape the armholes and slant the shoulders in same way as back and, at the same time, when work measures 33 (31-35) cm. from edge, to shape the neckline bind off the 28 (26-30) centre stit-

trom edge, to shape the neckline bind off the 28 (26-30) centre stitches and end the two parts separately decreasing centrewise1 st. every 2 rows 5 times.

Sleeves: with knitting needles 51/2 and the plum yarn cast on 48 (46-50) sts. and work edge in same way as back. Cont. in rows of openwork decreasing 4 sts. in row 1 and altenating the colours in same way as back. On sides incr. 1 st. after 10 rows and when work measures 10 (9-11) cm. from edge, to shape armholes bind off on sides, every 2 rows, 4 sts., 1 st. 14 (13-15) times. At 12 (11-13) cm. from beg. of armholes bind off the rem. 10 stitches.

Ribbon: to make ribbon with knitting needles 51/2 and the plum

**Ribbon:** to make ribbon, with knitting needles 51/2 and the plum yarn cast on 55 sts. and work in knit st. for 26 rows, corresponding to 11 cm; bind off the sts. For the knot of the ribbon, with the plum yarn cast on 12 sts and work in knit stitch for 32 rows, corresponding to 11 cm; bind off the sts. For the knot of the ribbon, with the plum yarn cast on 12 sts and work in knit stitch for 32 rows, corresponding to the state of t ding to 14 cm; bind off stitches.

### MAKE UP AND FINISH

**MAKE UP AND FINISH**Sew up the shoulders. With the circular knitting needles and the plum yarn pick up 102 (98-106) sts. around the neckline but not at the centre corresponding to 28 (26-30) sts., bind off; work in elastic rib for 10 rows, corresponding to 2 cm, then work over stitches with tapestry neelde. Sew knot at centre of ribbon tightening it slighltly; sew ribbon at base of neckline (see photo). Join and sew on the sleeves. Sew up the sides.
