


PATTERN STITCHES Elastic rib (start and end) Rib stitch 1/1 Knit stitch Short stitch over elastic rib

SHAWL

MATERIALS ADRIAFIL YARNS

MATERIALS REQUIRED 125 g. Mohair Stretch yarn pink no. 03. Knitting needles no. 3 and no 31/2. Tapestry needle.

SIZE: 42 (44-46)



GAUGE

10x10 cm. with knitting needles no. 31/2 in knit stitch = 24 sts. and 33 rows.

WORKING INSTRUCTIONS

Back: with knitting needles no. 3 cast on 114 (120-126) sts. and, to shape edge, work 2 rows in elastic rib, then cont. in rib stitch 1/1 until work measures 11 cm. Cont. with knitting needles no. 31/2 in knit stitch. When work measures 20 (21-22) cm. from edge, to shape armholes decr. on sides, inside the 3 sts., 2 sts. every 2 rows 5 (6-7) times. When work measures 18 (1-20) cm. from beg. bind off all rem. stitches.

Front: work in same way as back until work measures 21 (22-23) cm. from the edge. To shape the neckline, cross off the 26 centre sts. and end the two parts separately; cross off centrevise 3 sts. after 2 rows, then decr., inside the 3 sts., 2 sts. every 2 rows 7 times. At the same time, finish the armholes in same way as back. When work measures 17 (18-19) cm. from beg. of neckline bind off the rem. 17 (18-19) sts. for each shoulder.

MAKE UP AND FINISH

Sew up shoulder. With knitting needles no. 3 pick up 150 (168-176) sts. around the neckline and, to shape edge, work in rib stitch 1/1 for 1 cm., then in elastic rib for 2 rows; sew over the stitches. Join and sew on the other shoulder and the edges of the neckline. Trim armholes in the same way picking up for each 110 (114-118) sts. Sew up the sides and the edges of the armholes.
